The DNE will increase the awareness of diabetes and associated risk factors within the community at large and is a professional resource for health care providers in the area. Registered Nurse (RN) is responsible for performing the tasks and responsibilities as per the applicable professional associations and regulatory agencies such as the Ontario College of Nurses.
